For Alta De Jager baking is not simply a way to some money, but more importantly a way of giving back to the community. She has been baking koeksisters her entire life, and grew up helping her mom bake for the local church. She got the recipe from her mother and has been following that very same method her whole life. "Some people like soft koeksisters so I simply put a little more butter in but other than that, I have not changed a thing," says Alta.

Through her baking she secures a steady income for her and the three families that she supports with her little enterprise. These family members are always keen to assist with whatever needs to be done in the kitchen. At times this really helps, as Alta produces on average about 250 dozen a per week - a total that sometimes rises to 300 when needs be.

The sweet treats are mostly distributed to lodges and shops in the Lowveld and everything is baked according to orders placed. Alta has entered the Huletts Koeksister Champion Competition for 2012, and although she is much too humble to claim that her recipe is a winner, she has faith in her method as it has supported her and many others for quite some time. She moved to the Lowveld more than 30 years ago and has been baking and selling koeksisters ever since.
